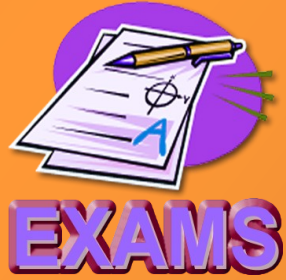

Semester Exams Reminders

Perfect Attendance OR Straight A = No exam(s)

- a) Students with perfect attendance, no undone or late work, and at least a C- in a class may skip the final exam for that class each semester. Perfect attendance is defined as having no class absences and no tardies, OR
 - b) Students who have a straight A in a class may skip the final exam for that class each semester.
(An A- is not an A)
1. Students are required to be present only for testing. Attendance will be taken and tardiness will be recorded as normal.
 2. If students have a free period between tests and remain at school, they are to go to the assigned study hall. Study halls will be held in the classroom of the teacher listed that hour. Likewise, those students who arrive early for a test should report to the classroom where the study hall is being held. Those students who desire to leave and go home, or go to the home of a friend, must present a written note from their parents. This note should be brought to the office that morning.
 3. Students not scheduled for tests that are waiting for a ride should go to the study hall.
 4. During a test, students are to remain in the room the entire period. Other study materials or reading materials should be brought along to the test in the event the test is completed before the allotted time.
 5. If students have tests before and after lunch, they are not allowed to leave school during the lunch period.
 6. If there is chapel, and if students have a test immediately before or after chapel, they are expected to attend chapel.
 7. Students whose attire does not comply with the HVL dress code will not be permitted to take exams.
